Housing Authority of Cook County (HACC)

- This is the agency that manages subsidized housing in the Suburbs of Cook County. Unlike Chicago Housing Authority, HACC's waitlists may be closed, but check back in as they may open again and remain open for a few days at a time.
- The best way to find out about these openings is to go to the HACC website
 (https://thehacc.org/) and sign up for email alerts (scroll to the bottom of the page and input your email).

Full Circle Communities

- Full Circle (https://www.fccommunities.org/our-communities/) operates many affordable housing developments throughout the following Chicago suburbs: Carol Stream, Elgin, Arlington Heights, Lake Zurich, McHenry, Richmond, and Lansing.
